



Coronavirus Home School Agreement

By signing this agreement, all parties agree to work together to keep the St Ignatius community, including families, as well as the wider community, safe from Covid-19.

We are currently unable to take in paper copies of documents therefore, unless we receive communication from you to the contrary, we will assume that you are in agreement with the expectations outlined below.

The Parent/Carer

I/We shall endeavour to: -

- Check that my child is in good health each morning before they leave for school.
- Refrain from sending them to school if they are displaying any symptoms of the coronavirus.
- Keep my child at home if any member of my household has displayed symptoms of the coronavirus in the last 14 days, unless that member of the household has had a negative result from a coronavirus test via the NHS/Public Health England.
- Inform the school immediately regarding any positive/negative test for coronavirus within my household.
- Provide the school with the most up to date details for contacting me.
- Make a member of my household available at all times whilst my child is at work, so I can be contacted in the event that they need to be picked up from school due to displaying covid symptoms.
- Be available to pick my child up from school as soon as possible if they are displaying covid like symptoms.
- Wash my child's uniform frequently to reduce the potential for the spread of the coronavirus on fabric. This includes facemasks.
- Understand and give consent for the school to take the temperature of my child before they are admitted into the building each day.
- Notify student services, with as much notice as possible, if my child is unable to attend school on a day they are expected to.

- Ensure that my child carries tissues with them at all times, in order to follow the Catch It, Bin It, Kill It protocol
- ensure that my child understands the importance of good hand hygiene and understands how to wash or sanitise their hands in line with Public Health England guidelines.
- Send our child to school with an adequate amount of water as I understand that during this time there will be no working water fountains on the school site.
- Ensure that my child continues to not bring a smartphone to school.
- Refrain from parking outside the school in a way that increases the risk of harm to any member of our community, pedestrians and other drivers.
- Ensure that my child follows the social distancing instructions from Transport for London when travelling on public transport
- Ensure that my child goes straight home on departure from school and limits interactions with people outside their household.
- Refrain from arriving at school without having arranged this with a member of the SLT previously
- Never enter the school site if we are displaying any symptoms of coronavirus
- Understand that it may not be possible to enter the school site except in the case of an emergency.
- Understand that where an onsite meeting is necessary, only one parent or carer will attend
- Avoid gathering at the school gate and will maintain good social distancing whilst waiting for my child.
- Ensure that my child reads and follows the rules and expectations regarding remote learning.
- Ensure my child understands the Code of Conduct coronavirus addendum and will follow it at all times on the school site.
- Understand that a failure to follow the Code of Conduct coronavirus addendum may result in a fixed term exclusion for my child.

- Make my child aware of the expected behaviour detailed in the Code of Conduct coronavirus addendum and the importance of following these behaviours at all times.
- Be fully supportive of any decision the school makes in relation to sanctions given to your child due to their failure to follow the Code of Conduct coronavirus addendum.
- Understand that any failure to follow the terms of this agreement will lead to my child being sanctioned in line with the Ignatian code of conduct, and the addendum to the Ignatian code of conduct.
