

Oversubscription Criteria

When the number of applicants exceeds the published admission number, offers of places are made using the following criteria in order of priority:

1. Catholic “looked after” children and previously “looked after” Catholic children who have been adopted or made subject to child arrangement orders, or special guardianship orders.
2. Baptised Catholic boys with a Certificate of Catholic Practice (CCP).
3. Other baptised Catholic boys
4. Other “looked after” children and previously “looked after” children who have been adopted or made subject to child arrangement orders or special guardianship orders.
5. Baptised boys by Eastern/Orthodox Churches where the application is supported by a baptism certificate or a certificate of reception and Catechumens with a certificate of entry into the order of Catechumens.
6. Boys from Christian families where application is supported by a baptism certificate, or a letter from the Minister of religion confirming membership of the Parish Community.
7. Boys of families from other faiths where the application is supported by a letter from a religious leader of the faith confirming membership of the faith community.
8. Any other boys.
